The position is responsible for providing direct support to a Korean female client who is diagnosed with early onset dementia. **The Disability Support Worker is required to support the female participants for 24/7 in supported accommodation**, by adhering to various Individual Plans that are designed to maximize positive outcomes and achieve her individual goals.

### **Main Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Provide and/or assist participants with personal care, household chores, community access and maximizing participants’ independence at home and in the community.
- Apply person-centred approach when working with a participant to explore and resolve a variety of her complex needs and expectations;
- Provide timely reporting on services provided to a participant and maintain close communication with immediate supervisors;
- Work collaboratively with team members;
- Maintain professional boundaries;
- Protect and respect the privacy, dignity and rights of the participant; and
